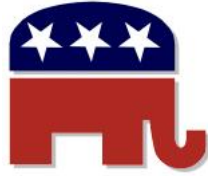

Turning Patriotism Into Action



You won't find Jack Janik's name on Wikipedia.com under its Flag Day entry, but maybe you

should.

Since becoming president of the Flag Day Foundation 17 years ago, Janik has helped to grow the annual Flag Day event to one that attracts about 10,000 annually.

Waubeka is already recognized

as the birthplace of Flag Day thanks to a then 19-year-old local teacher names John Cigrand, who in 1885 put a small flag on his desk and asked students to write about what the flag meant to them. He later led rallies to draw national attention to the importance of the flag. Finally, in 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day.

Under Janik's leadership, the Flag Day Foundation received non-profit status, purchased a 13,000-square-foot former school and 15 acres of land,

built the Americanism Center Avenue of Flags to educate schoolchildren and citizens about the importance of the flag, built three museums and created a commemorative courtyard.

"Everything within the building and on the grounds are used as an educational tool, to teach the lessons of our flag and the symbol of our great Country," Janik said.

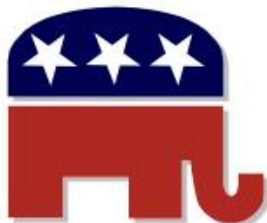
