AG: Another Successful Crackdown on Illegal Aliens

Readers of J.B.'s Journal know that the AG has transformed DOJ's approach towards cracking down on criminal illegal immigration. Since J.B. created a partnership with the Immigrations and Custom Enforcement (ICE), they have removed over 300 criminal illegal aliens from Wisconsin streets.

Last week J.B. announced that a joint operation with ICE netted 49 arrests in central and western Wisconsin. Here is what J.B. had to say about the successful operation:

"This operation undertaken through the heart of our state shows the depth and breadth of the threat to Wisconsin communities, big and small, urban and rural, posed by criminal illegal aliens. Our cooperative efforts are yielding results that make our state safer."
