### [What They Told Us: Reviewing Last Week's Key Polls](#)

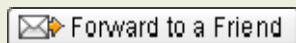


One of the key issues in the political debate now roiling the country is how big a part government should play in our lives.

### [Election 2010: West Virginia Senate Special Election](#)

Now that state legislators have officially approved a special Senate election this November to replace the late Robert Byrd, the state's Democratic governor still earns majority support to win the job. The latest Rasmussen Reports statewide telephone survey of Likely Voters shows Governor Joe Manchin picking up 51% of the vote when matched against businessman John Raese, who picks up 35%.

### [North Dakota House: Berg \(R\) 49%, Pomeroy \(D\) 46%](#)

The race to represent North Dakota in the U.S. House of Representatives appears a little tighter this month. The latest Rasmussen Reports telephone survey of Likely Voters in North Dakota shows Republican Rick Berg with 49% support to Democratic incumbent Earl Pomeroy's 46%. Just one percent (1%) prefer some other candidate in the race, while five percent (5%) are undecided.
