Fifty-four percent (54%) of U.S. voters say the Justice


Department should take legal action against cities that provide sanctuary for illegal immigrants.

Even more think the federal government should cut off funds to these "sanctuary cities."

A new Rasmussen Reports national telephone survey finds that just 30% say the federal government should not take legal action against cities that offer illegal immigrants various forms of sanctuary.

[Massachusetts Governor: Patrick \(D\) 38%, Baker \(R\) 32%, Cahill \(I\) 17%](#)

Massachusetts' spirited gubernatorial contest remains largely unchanged this month, with incumbent Democratic Governor Deval Patrick holding onto a small lead. A new Rasmussen Reports telephone survey of Likely Voters in the Bay State finds Patrick with 38% support, while Republican Charlie Baker picks up 32% of the vote.

Republican candidates now hold a 10-point lead over Democrats on the Generic Congressional Ballot for the week ending Sunday, July 25, the widest gap between the two parties in several weeks. A new Rasmussen Reports national telephone survey finds that 46% of Likely Voters would vote for their district's Republican congressional candidate, while 36% would opt for his or her Democratic opponent.
